

Initial Vanderbilt Assessment Scale Scoring Instructions

To Make a DSM-Based Diagnosis for ADHD using the Vanderbilt Assessment Scales, a patient must meet criteria for **SYMPTOMS AND IMPAIRMENT** in **TWO SETTINGS** (i.e. Home and School).

Questions #1 – 9 screen for Inattentive Symptoms

Questions # 10 – 18 screen for Hyperactive Symptoms

Questions A – H screen for Impairment

To Calculate the Total Symptom Score (TSS): Find the sum of all of the 0s, 1s, 2s, and 3s that have been circled in Questions 1 – 18. The maximum score in this section is 54.

To Calculate the Average Performance Score (APS): Find the sum of all the 1s, 2s, 3s, 4s and 5s that have been circled in Questions A through H. Next, divide this calculated sum by the total number of questions that have been answered.

The Vanderbilt Rating Scales also screen for the most common psychiatric diagnoses co-morbid with ADHD – including **Oppositional Defiant Disorder (ODD), Conduct Disorder (CD), and Anxiety/Depression.** Once again, **SYMPTOMS AND IMPAIRMENT** must be present in **TWO SETTINGS** (i.e. Home and School) (Note: On the Teacher Assessment form, ODD and CD are combined into ONE section.)
